

**Regular Board Meeting**  
**November 17, 2015**  
**8:00 p.m.**

The McCrory School District Board of Education met in a regular board meeting on November 17, 2015 at 8:00 p.m. in the administration building with the following members in attendance: Jeff Reeves, Craig Reeves, Bob Briley, Bobby Best and Sean Williams. The President, Sean Williams, called the meeting to order at 8:01 p.m. and the following business was conducted:

1. A motion as made by Bob Briley with a second from Craig Reeves to approve the consent agenda:
  - a. Approval and signing of the minutes from the regular board meeting on October 19, 2015 and the special board meeting on October 29, 2015
  - b. Financial reports, lunch, activity
2. Mrs. Debbie Runyon, elementary principal, gave a report on the elementary school. Mrs. Runyon noted that Frank Swanson sent a letter to the elementary school complementing our students behavior at his art studio when they visited for a school field trip.
3. Mr. Aaron Wiggins, high school principal, gave a report on the high school. He discussed the play-off football games and how excited everyone in the school was. He also mentioned that the new scoreboard and twenty-five second clocks at the football field have been installed and are working.
4. Mr. Casteel discussed the district finances, which are in good standing.
5. The high school has a student that has been accepted at the Sunshine School in Searcy.
6. Mr. Casteel gave a report on new phone systems for the District. The current phone system is out of date and if one goes out, there aren't parts to repair it.
7. LED lighting has been installed in the high school. Mr. Casteel gave a comparison with the electric bill from November 2015 to November 2014. We are seeing a decrease but next months should show a significant savings.

8. Mr. Casteel, Bryan Lowery and Chris Snyder are still talking with Apptegy about the design of the new district website.
9. An enrollment report was given to the Board. The District has a total of 626 students Pre-k through twelfth grade.
10. Mr. Casteel discussed the building projects that are going on at the high school campus.
11. A motion was made by Jeff Reeves with a second from Bobby Best to proceed on the art / testing building with RPPY moving forward with the bidding process.
12. Mr. Casteel noted that we were in the football playoff games and they will all be held here as long as we win them.
13. The ASBA Conference was brought up and all board members and the superintendent are attending.
14. A motion was by Craig Reeves with a second from Bobby Best to hire Stanley Ball as bus driver for \$11.50 per hour to run the Sunshine School route. All were in favor of the motion.
15. President Sean Williams declared the meeting adjourned at 9:57 p.m.
